CHARLESTON PARK CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. All service fees are to be paid in full prior to collection or dispatch of any semen
2. Service fees are non refundable.
3. Collection of and transportation costs for the semen are payable by the Owner.
4. In the case that the stallion should be injured to prevent breeding, die or be sold, the mare owner is entitled to a full refund (excluding the costs already incurred).
5. Mare owners are advised that a live foal guarantee does not guarantee that a live foal will be born by the mare being bred. This term entitles the mare owner to a return breeding for the same mare to the same stallion, the following year. This applies only in the case that the mare should a) fail to conceive, b) abort the foetus or c) the foal die within 24hrs of birth. A veterinary certificate must be supplied.
6. Should the mare owner fail to have a veterinarian examine the pregnancy for twins or abortions at or before eighteen days (18) after insemination, and between forty (40) and sixty (60) days after conception, the live foal guarantee will be void. It is the responsibility of the mare owner to assist in maintaining the pregnancy with regular veterinary checks. Charleston Park will not honour Live Foal Guarantees when the mare owner has neglected to undertake appropriate examinations.
7. Charleston Park must be notified within seven (7) days of the results of the pregnancy test as outlined above (point 6) or the live foal guarantee will be void.
8. The Stud will not honour Live Foal Guarantees when the mare loses a pregnancy due to poor health caused from owner's neglect. Appropriate feed, water and shelter should be available to the pregnant mare at all times.
9. A \$220 rebreeding fee will be charged upon exercising the Live Foal Guarantee. This also applies to any mares needing to be rebred for subsequent seasons.
10. The breeding season will commence on 1st October and close on the 1st day of February each year. Mares must be bred within this period.
11. The Stud exercises the right to refuse any mare for breeding for whatever reasons.
12. Mare owners are advised to have their mares assessed for breeding soundness before breeding by an appropriately qualified veterinarian.
13. All accounts are to be paid in full before service certificates will be issued.
14. Service certificates cannot be issued without appropriate registration papers or proof of identity.
15. Semen can be collected and shipped on any day of the week however additional transportation fees apply to Monday, Saturday and Sunday deliveries.

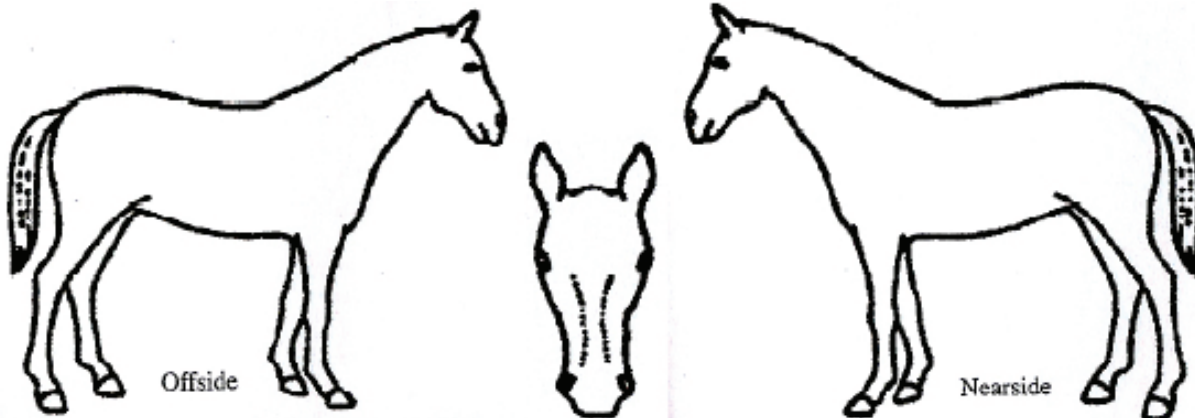
Additional conditions for live cover- (Approved Clients Only)

1. Charleston Park will take all care for mares being served but no responsibility for any injuries should they occur. Owners are advised to be aware of the risks involved with naturally breeding horses.
2. Charleston Park does not recommend natural service for maiden mares.
3. Any mare requiring treatment and/ or professional handling in the case of them being difficult to handle will be treated as such. The use of sedatives or twitches will be used as appropriate restraints during serving. The mare owner will be responsible for payment of all drugs used. The stud will take no risks with mares that are a danger to themselves or the stallion.
4. The Stud requests the right to administer hormone treatment for breeding if required eg administration of prostaglandin injection to shorten the breeding cycle. All treatments will be payable by the mare owner.
5. All accounts are to be paid in full before the mare/semen will be allowed to leave the Stud.
